

Compliance to Patients Mobility Criteria

E-Zec Medical believes it is important to keep in touch with its' valued staff.

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Introduction:

To prevent a serious incident when a crew transports a patient, they **MUST** use the Patients Transport Criteria that had been requested. (As per PTS-SOP- 03 Carriage of patient transport services patients Mobility section 6)

Patient Transport Criteria

Single Crew (CW/1PC) The crew member must always assist the patient accessing and egressing the vehicle, home and destination. A wheelchair might be required. (1PC)

Single Crew (TIOC1) The crew member must transport the patient in the own wheelchair that has been 'crash tested'

Double Crew (2PC) The crew members must use a wheelchair to transport the patient accessing and egressing the vehicle, home and destination.

Double Crew (TIOC2) (LWCH) The crew member must transport the patient in the own wheelchair that has been 'crash tested' and secured using the correct equipment and procedure

Double Crew (STR) (Bstr) The Patient must be transported on the ambulance stretcher ensuring they are secure.

In law, a duty of care is a legal obligation which is imposed on an individual requiring adherence to a standard of reasonable care while performing any acts that could foreseeably harm others. It is the first element that must be established to proceed with an action in negligence.

Important.

If when you arrive at the patient that the transport criteria are not correct contact control immediately.



Only use the correct equipment



Remember by Law you have a Duty of Care
